Conflict of Interest

1. Listen 4 Change (L4C) members should disclose any perceived interest in the decision making, whether it be personal or on behalf of another group they consider will affect their participating in the matter under discussion.
2. L4C members must not expect to receive more or less favourable treatment because they are a member of L4C or represent L4C.
3. L4C members should make it clear, when attending meetings or events, whether they are there as a representative of L4C (which has been approved) or as a parent carer.
4. L4C members must use the normal procedures for reporting incidents or making complaints to services.
5. If it is felt that a Steering Group member or Parent Representative is acting in their own best interests or on behalf of another organisation that they have declared as a Conflict of Interest, this will be considered a breach of the Code of Conduct.
